Each book then needs to be covered in plastic. Books to be covered by the **end of 1st week** of the school year.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Each learner from grade R to Grade 7 will be required to own their personal iPad, Android device or laptop for learning. These are to be brought to school daily and fully charged. All background updating and downloads are to be disengaged. We have limited bandwidth and any additional unnecessary usage cannot be accommodated. Any misuse of the device will result in the device being confiscated immediately and handed to the parent. The misbehaviour will be addressed between the teacher, parent and learner before the device is returned to the learner.

Grade 4 - 7 students are specifically recommended to use a laptop as it is able to access all types of applications associated with Google Classroom. However, a tablet is sufficient if it is able to download and fully function the following applications:
